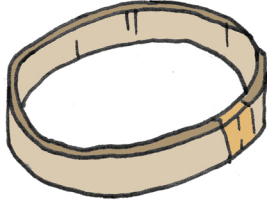


The Nutcracker

Mouse Ears

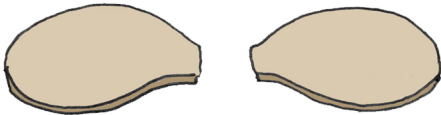

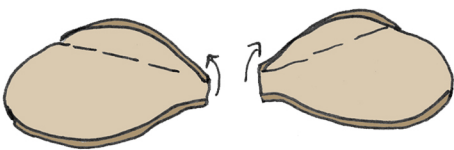
Cut a strip of cardboard, about 4cm wide and long enough to go around your head. Wrap it around your head and secure in place with tape. Pay attention to the grain of the cardboard to let it curve easily.

2.



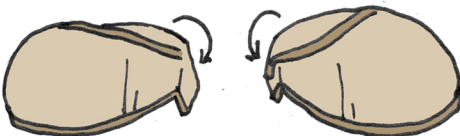
Use the pattern guides to cut out the mouse ear shapes.

3.



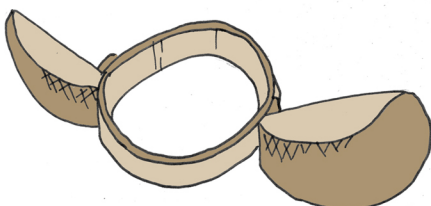
Fold the top edge up and flatten to crease (you can use the recommended fold line in the pattern guide to show where to fold)

4.



Fold the inside edge behind and flatten to crease (you can use the recommended fold line in the pattern guide to show where to fold... again)

5.



Attach the ears to the head loop using the flap behind we made in step 4. You can attach the ears with tape, hot glue, pva glue or a split pin.

Now put your mouse ears on, practise your cheesemas tunes and get to the theatre!

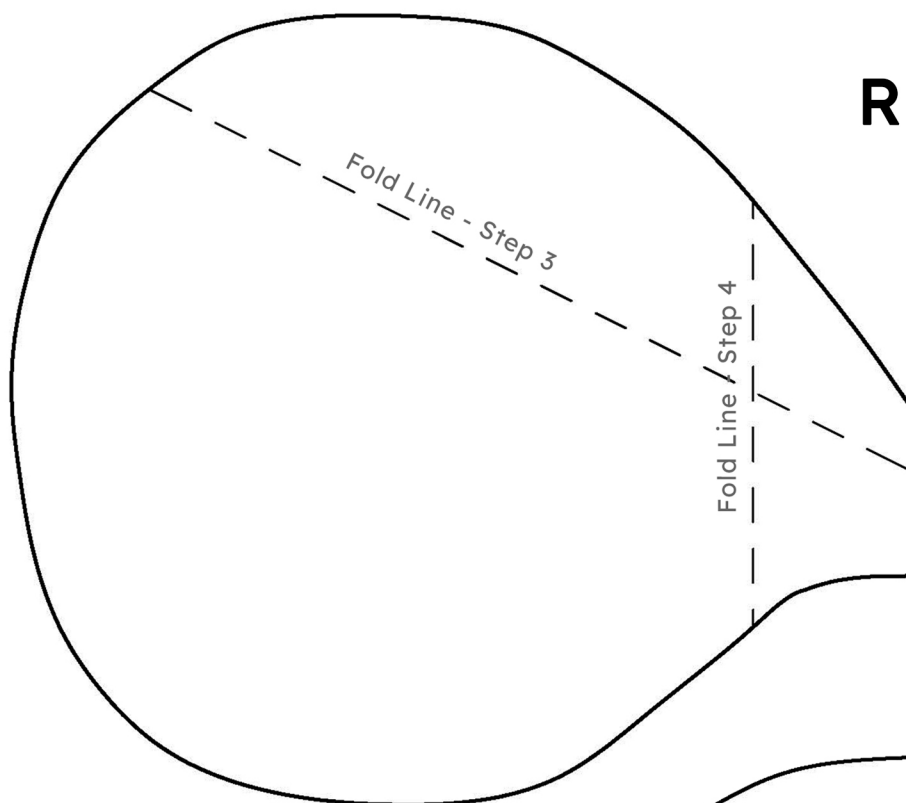
